As a member of the Editorial Board of the British Journal of Surgery and Chairman of the Program Committee of the European Society of Coloproctology he is very familiar with the evolution of coloproctology throughout Europe. Professor Tiret will deliver the 20th Edward Wilson Lecture entitled "Managing the patient with low rectal cancer - a French perspective".

We are also very pleased to welcome Professor Paul Finan from Leeds General Infirmary who is one of Britain's most respected colorectal surgeons. Professor Finan will be well known to many of you as a previous guest lecturer at CME meetings. His clear presentation style promises to reveal his broad experience and depth of knowledge.

For many reasons the Sydney Colorectal Surgical Society will not be continuing in its previous format this year, but we are confident that its annual spring meeting, and in particular the Edward Wilson Lecture, will continue in perpetuity delivered by those who have made a substantial international contribution to colorectal surgery.
